STARTING OVER

The story of the "Prodigal Son" teaches several priceless lessons. One of these is about making a new beginning. Here is a young man who wasted (the meaning of "prodigal") what his father had provided and, finally coming to the place of "godly sorrow," (2 Corinthians 7:10) he was moved to return to his home in full repentance.



The scriptures are full of examples of those who started over. Adam and Eve essentially started over when God drove them from the garden of Eden; the ancient nation of Israel had to start over many times in their long relationship with God; Peter started over after his denial of Jesus; Paul started over in a new relationship with God through Jesus Christ.

Paul may very well have had his own new start in mind when he wrote to the Corinthians about living for Jesus Christ rather than for themselves. "Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation; the old has gone, the new has come!" (2 Corinthians 5:17)

As we begin a new year, let us be encouraged to make a new beginning in our relationship with God and with our fellow man. It may not be easy, but if we have Paul's confidence (which wasn't in himself, but in God. See Romans 7:7-8:2), we can succeed: "I can do all things through him who strengthens me." (Philippians 4:13, ESV)
