## WORSHIP



One of our greatest privileges as the people of God is the opportunity to worship God. However, worship just might be one of the most difficult things that we do. Worship is difficult because most of us have received little training in how to worship—we have learned by observation. Second, worship is difficult because it demands concentration, and there may be many distractions that interrupt concentration. Third, worship is difficult because we have a tendency to think that worship is primarily for us and if we are not pleased, amused, or satisfied we may choose not to worship. However, worship is primarily for God and when we worship Him in the right way we then receive great benefits. Here are some facts about worship based upon Jesus' great statement about worship found in John 4:23-24.

1. God is the object of worship. We worship God, Jesus said, "God is Spirit, and those who worship Him..." First, we must focus on God in worship as we think about what He has done for us, what He is doing, and what He will yet do.
2. We worship God in spirit. Jesus said, "Those who worship Him must worship in spirit..." This must mean that worship comes from humble hearts that are devoted to God. Worship is more than going through the motions. Worship is what we do with our whole heart, in God's way.
3. We worship God in truth. Jesus said, "Those who worship Him must worship...in truth." Since God's Word is truth (John 17:17), our Lord must be saying that we worship God as He teaches us how in His Word. All that we know about worship is revealed in Scripture. What we do in worship must be the things God authorizes.
4. God seeks true worshippers. Jesus said, "The Father is seeking such (true worshippers who worship in spirit and truth) to worship Him." God is worthy of our worship. He seeks true worshippers. He wants our worship to be in spirit and truth. Should we not offer such worship to Him? Should we not be true worshippers? Should we not assemble with the church regularly to worship the Father "in spirit and truth"? Can we expect to see you Sunday?
