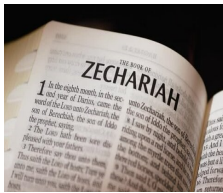

FROM THE PREACHER

What is Repentance of an Unscriptural Remarriage? #1, Introduction

In my recent sermon on divorce, I deliberately avoided the hotly debated question, "Does remarriage after an unscriptural divorce create an *ongoing* adulterous relationship?" Or, to put the question in another way, "Does repentance of an unscriptural divorce and remarriage require a person to divorce their current spouse?" I avoided this question because I wished to take my time to explain my position in more depth here in these articles. I'm under no illusion that these articles will end the debate – this subject has been debated hotly for decades, with faithful Christians coming to different conclusions. My aim is much simpler: to help us all think through this subject biblically and to explain my position clearly.

The question is not about the sinfulness of divorce – divorce *always* involves sin, either of one or both parties. And, depending on the situation, a remarriage may be sinful as well. But as to the actual debate over whether an unscriptural remarriage creates a perpetually adulterous relationship, allow me to state my position plainly: *No, while an unscriptural remarriage begins with an act of adultery, it does not create an ongoing adulterous relationship. That being the case, repenting of an unscriptural remarriage does not require divorcing one's current spouse. Repentance in this case would mean committing oneself to never again divorce and remarry.*

Please note that I'm not shrugging off unscriptural remarriage, far from it. An unscriptural remarriage absolutely begins with an act of adultery (Matthew 5:31–32, 19:9; Mark 10:11–12; Luke 16:18). It is not to be done, and the Church should not condone such sin. However, repentance of an unscriptural remarriage does not mean divorcing again; it means committing to *not* divorcing and remarrying again. An analogy may be helpful here: I view a sinful remarriage similar to how I would view murder. Repenting of murder does not mean un-murdering the person, it means not murdering anymore. Likewise, repenting from a sinful divorce and remarriage does not mean divorcing again, it means not divorcing and remarrying anymore.

To cut an objection off at the pass: Saying that a couple can repent of their sinful remarriage without divorcing does not give permission for sinful remarriages. In the same way, saying that a person can repent of murder without un-murdering does not give permission for murder. The grace of God is real, but it does not give license to sin, as Paul explains in depth in Romans 6.

I'll close this introduction with a quote from James Burton Coffman, who I think speaks wisely on this subject. He reminds us of the messiness of sin and the need for humility:

"The law of God is easy to understand. Problems arise only from the complications that set in when men sin, giving rise to all kinds of fantastic situations. For those who find themselves entangled in such frustrations and contradictions rising out of violations of God's basic law, it is not recommended that they "solve" their problems in the dim light of human legislation, but rather by casting themselves upon the mercy of God. Vast numbers of situations exist today for which no proper or truly adequate solution is possible. Human laws, the opinions of ecclesiastics, the canon law of churches, the judgments of preachers, bishops, or popes, are all valueless in this area where only God has the right to legislate." (Coffman's commentary on Matthew 19:9)
