



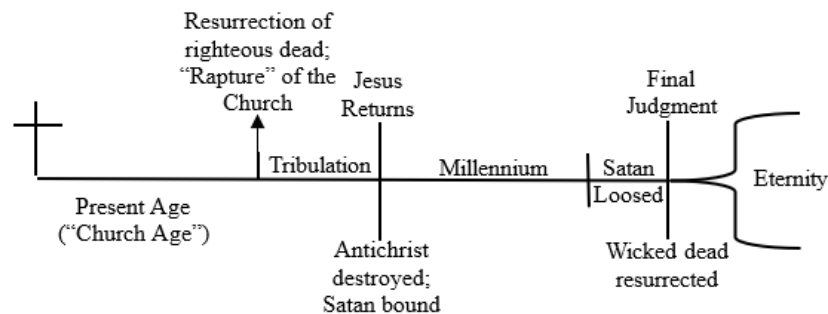

## Views on “the Millennium”: Dispensational Premillennialism

We now come to the last of the four major views on the millennium: dispensational premillennialism (which we'll simply call “dispensationalism”). Dispensationalism developed in the 19<sup>th</sup> century, but became very popular in the 20<sup>th</sup> century through the influence of the Scofield Reference Bible, Moody Bible Institute, and popular works such as *The Late Great Planet Earth* and the *Left Behind* series.

What makes dispensationalism unique is its strict separation of Israel and the Church into two distinct peoples of God with two distinct purposes. Most people who hold an a-, post-, or historic pre- millennial position, on the other hand, would argue that believing Jews *and* Gentiles collectively make up the one true Israel, the Church. This distinction between Israel and the Church leads to the idea that the Church is a temporary measure which was made necessary by Israel's rejection of Jesus as the Messiah. On this view, God has basically paused his plan for the Jews until a certain point in the future (the pre-tribulation rapture of the Church). In the meantime, God works with and through the Church. To be fair, dispensationalists would not say that God's “Plan A” *failed* and now he is having to work out a “Plan B.” They would say that even though the Church was not alluded to in the Old Testament (since on their view the OT promises are for ethnic Israel alone), nevertheless, the cross and the Church were all part of God's master plan.

Essentially, dispensationalism takes the scheme of historic premillennialism and makes it much more focused on ethnic Israel. As mentioned, on this view God is currently working with and through the Church, but at some point in the future will take the Church into heaven, leaving everyone else on earth. Those left on earth will then have to go through seven years of tribulation, during which the antichrist will rule and things will go from bad to worse. At the end of the tribulation, Jesus will return, destroy the antichrist, bind Satan, and establish his kingdom on earth for 1000 years. During this time, Jesus will rule from Jerusalem and a new temple will be built for sacrifices and temple activity to resume (see Ezekiel 40–48). After 1000 years, Satan will be released for a short period of time and will stage one final battle. Jesus will defeat Satan, the wicked will be raised and judged, and eternity will ensue. A very simplified timeline of dispensational premillennialism would look something like this:



While very popular within Evangelicalism as a whole, Dispensationalism has almost always been rejected within churches of Christ. R. H. Boll is the primary exception to this rule and is one of the very few leaders within churches of Christ to adopt dispensational views.
