- Please pray for good health and prosperity for the Barrently Family.

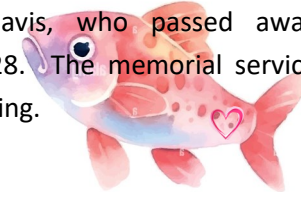
