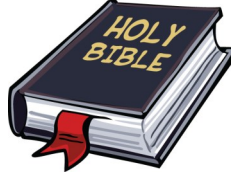

Happy New Year! I hope and pray, as you read this article, that the past few days have already been filled with many great blessings! If you were here this past Sunday, then you saw our 2024 theme Banners are up on the wall. You may have also noticed a few changes from the previous years. Our Theme for 2024 is "Redeemed." I am excited to share with you a number of the series and sermons revolving around the idea of being redeemed, freed, and delivered by God.

What you will notice is that I do not have my monthly series listed on the banners, which was done purposefully. I think it's important that I make myself available to members of this congregation, so every Monday and Wednesday you can expect to find me in my office working. I invite you to stop by, have a seat, drink some coffee, and visit whenever you like. I'm open to discussing the Bible, or whatever you might have on your mind. Tuesdays, this year, my focus is going to be on outward evangelism. My focus is on being available to the community and evangelizing to those in need. This might be visiting with city officials and local educators, or simply Bible studies at our local coffee shop. If you hope to reach me on Tuesday you will have better luck in the afternoons, but don't forget that my phone is always on, so don't hesitate to reach out. Lastly, on Thursday my focus will be on the members of this congregation, that's not to say I'm not focusing on you'll any other day, but specifically on Thursday I will spend my time visiting with members, checking on those who are sick, and reaching out to those we have not seen in a while. The work of a preacher never ceases, but when you love what you do it's not work! I can't wait to share with you several other new things we have on the horizon, but for now, I'll leave it there.
