There is a sign-up sheet in the foyer if you would like to host a Youth Devo.

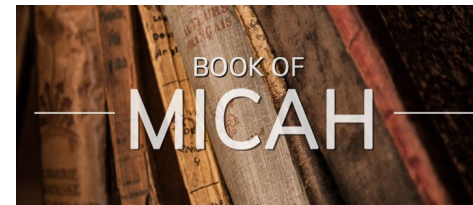


Chelsea Plata was baptized into Christ on Sunday December 29th! We look forward to helping her grow in spirit and in truth in the Kingdom of God!
