A NOTE FROM THE PREACHER

A Little About Us

Hi there! My family and I are so excited to be joining the Angleton Church of Christ. I thought it would be good for me to take this first bulletin article to introduce myself and my family in order to give you a bit of our background. I'm fairly local, having grown up in Crosby, roughly an hour northeast of here. I began attending the Crosby Church of Christ in 1999 and that has been my home congregation until now; before that (1992–1999), I was at the Channelview Church of Christ.

I attended the University of Houston from 2010–2014, where I earned a B.S. in Mechanical Engineering. More importantly, Hannah also attended UH which allowed us to meet at the campus ministry, Cougars for Christ. Hannah is originally from Haltom City (near Fort Worth) and moved to Houston for college. It is through Cougars for Christ that she became a Christian, being baptized at Impact Church of Christ in 2017. She graduated from UH in May 2018 and we married in September of that year. Our daughter, Dani, was born in 2020 and our first son, Samuel (bonus points if you can figure out why we named him Samuel!) was born in 2023. We are expecting our second son, Luke, in August. Right now, most of our

free time is spent with the kids – riding bikes / scooters, going to the park, playing Paw Patrol, and so on.
