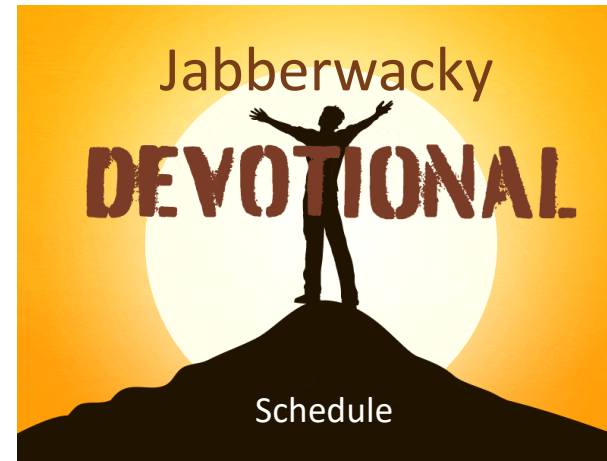
From the Preacher's Desk

The ABC's of Psalm 119 - David Olmos

Beginning this Sunday evening we will start a sermon series through Psalm 119. It's not only the longest chapter in the Bible, it also mentions God's Word more than any other. 176 total verses and every single one, except two, mention God's Word in some way. We are going to break down that Psalm into the sections we find in the scriptures, and uncover more about God's Truth. I am excited to share my thoughts on a wonderful part of our Bible. For our article today I wanted to share with you something that came across my desk. I hope it encourages you as much as it does me.

What Does God's Word Accomplish? Psalm 119 gives us the answers!
