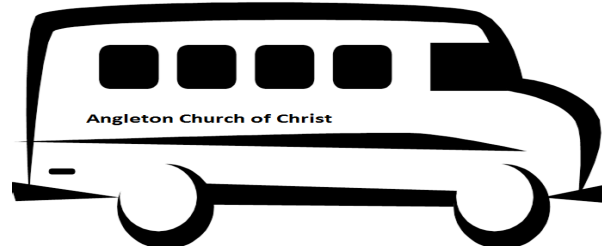

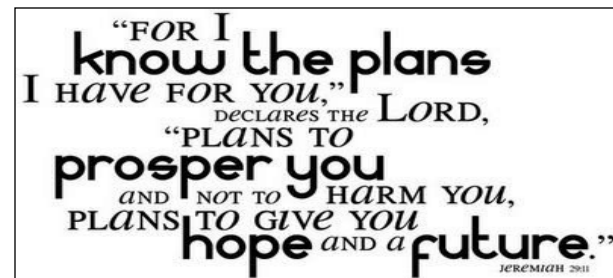


If you are participating in Trek, you need to have all your paperwork completed by Wednesday, June 19th
