

## Views on “the Millennium”: A-Millennialism

One of the perennial debates among Christians is over the nature of the 1000 years, or “the millennium,” referenced in Revelation 20:6–7,

*<sup>6</sup> Blessed and holy is the one who shares in the first resurrection! Over such the second death has no power, but they will be priests of God and of Christ, and they will reign with him for a thousand years. <sup>7</sup> And when the thousand years are ended, Satan will be released from his prison...*

Is this a literal thousand-year period, or symbolic? When does it occur in relation to Jesus’s return and the tribulation? These and other questions have been debated throughout Christian history. There are four major views on the millennium: amillennialism, postmillennialism, historic premillennialism, and dispensational premillennialism. What I would like to do in the next few articles is introduce you to the various views. In this first article, we will consider amillennialism.

Please know that the explanations provided in these articles are necessarily simplified. Within each view is a variety of small differences. These articles are intended to act as an introduction, not an exhaustive (and exhausting!) treatment of the subject. Now, without further ado, amillennialism!

### Amillennialism

The name “amillennialism” suggests “no-millennium,” which is unfortunately misleading. Amillennialism *does* believe there is a millennium; however, the millennium is understood to be *symbolic*, not literal. According to amillennialism, the millennium is the undefined period of time between Jesus’s ascension and return. In other words, it is the age in which we are currently living (sometimes called “the Church age”). We are *now* in the millennium. Generally, the millennium is understood to end when Jesus returns. However, some would argue that the millennium technically ends at the “release of Satan,” a short period of intense persecution and apostasy immediately preceding Jesus’s return. At Jesus’s return, all the dead will be raised and there will be a final judgment, followed by eternity. Amillennialism is generally the default view within churches of Christ today. Visually, amillennialism could be represented as follows:

## POTLUCK

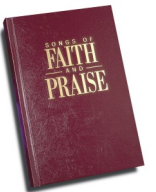
We will have a potluck lunch after morning worship this Sunday, March 22nd.
