- Peace in the Church

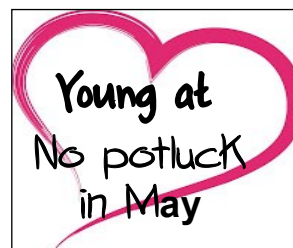
You will enjoy this day of praying for peace. You will want to be here. We are having a scripture reading and prayer for each of these areas.
