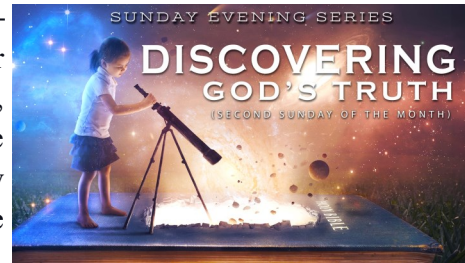
## From the Preacher's Desk - "Allow Me to Introduce..."

Second Sunday of the month – **"Discovering God's Truth"** –

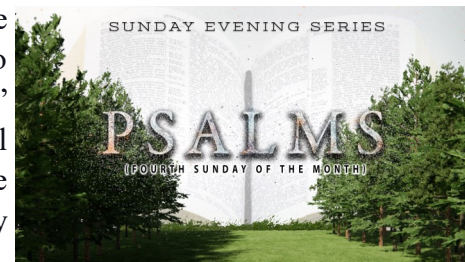
