From the Preacher's Desk

GROWTH Children's Group—David Olmos

There have been some questions about the name of our new young kid's group, mostly curious about what it means, and what we will be doing. I wanted to take a moment and share with you more about our new group and an update on some upcoming events. Over the past few years, our congregation has been blessed with more families coming and worshiping with us each week! While we have our regular YOUTH GROUP...I noticed our younger kids (infants - 5th grade) were growing in number but didn't have any structured group of their own. The question was asked: Why can't these kids have a group that meets and has activities for their age? They can! And thus we created the "GROWTH: Children's Group!"



My focus is on creating an environment and opportunity for this age group to grow closer to God and form lasting relationships with friends that will "grow" with them while they are a part of our congregation. Many of them already get together for playdates, or each other's birthdays, so why not get them together with an emphasis on God's Truth!?! For those who have been wondering if GROWTH was an acronym, the answer is...yes and no! While I did not initially have an acronym in mind when putting the group together, it was more about the idea of growing together and growing closer to God; I couldn't help but search a little and put something together.

God, Relationships, Opportunities, Wisdom, Truth, and Help!

God is first and foremost the most important part of our lives and the lives of our young kids. Next comes the **relationships** we form with those around us. We teach our kids to live the scriptures, like, "love your neighbor as yourself" (Mark 12:31). Therefore, we want to provide our kids with **opportunities** to put into action the things that they learn. It's one thing to be told, "give to those in need", and another thing to volunteer at a local animal shelter, or food pantry. While our kids have regular Bible study opportunities each week, I wanted to find hands-on events to increase their **wisdom** and understanding of the **truth**. That means we will have devotionals at the building before visiting a local firehouse, museum, aquarium, park, etc. We want the lessons they have learned to come to life! Lastly, we provide a **helping** hand to not only those in the community but personally to our kids and their families. At any time, children can sign-up for private Bible studies, family Bible studies, or counseling sessions. I truly believe that families that grow closer together, grow closer to God!

While this group is primarily focused on those kids in 5th grade and below, it's also a benefit to their parents who will have opportunities to fellowship with other families going through a similar lot in life. However, this new group is a benefit for the whole congregation. Every event we have, like our upcoming dinner, Devo, and pumpkin carving on Friday, October 21st, is open to the whole congregation. Our young kids consider many of you "spiritual" grandparents, aunts, and uncles. They would love to have you come and enjoy some fellowship with them. There will also be chances for you to host this group in your home if that is something you think you'd like to do. While we won't meet as frequently as our regular youth group, we will meet as often as we can. If for no other reason, than to strengthen their relationships with friends that will carry them through high school and beyond. So please, if I might request, pray for this new group.
