## FROM THE PREACHER

Michael Faraday: Scientist and Christian

(The facts below are taken from the journal article "Brother Faraday" by Herbert T. Pratt, found in *Restoration Quarterly* 31, 1989)

$$\epsilon = -N(d\phi/dt)$$

Chances are, the equation above means nothing to you, but some readers may be among the few who recognize it as Faraday's Law of Electromagnetic Induction, developed by one of the greatest scientists of the 19<sup>th</sup> century, Michael Faraday. Faraday's work in the fields of electricity, magnetism, and chemistry remain highly influential to this day. In his own time, he received honorary doctorates from the universities of Oxford, Cambridge, and Prague and honors from ninety-five government and scientific institutions. Faraday is known the world over as a scientist of the highest caliber, but what is not as commonly known is that Faraday was also a most devout Christian.

Faraday was a member of a small congregation of the churches of Christ in London (which were commonly referred to in England as Sandemanians, much like early congregations in the States were referred to as Campbellites). His faith was instilled and nurtured by his parents, and as a young man Faraday made an absolute commitment to Jesus as his Lord – a commitment from which he never wavered. For Faraday, living a life dedicated to his Lord was paramount, and that included dedication to the Lord's Church. As a world-famous scientist, he was frequently in demand for lectures, but Faraday made a point to always be home by Saturday evening in order to attend worship services on Sunday. On occasion, it was not possible for him to be at his home congregation, but even then, he would seek out the closest congregation to meet with and inform his home congregation of where he would be. Faraday also served as an elder for many years, regularly teaching and preaching in his congregation.

While he did not use his fame as a platform to actively evangelize, Faraday's faith was well known among his colleagues and he was universally admired for his dedication to living out the tenets of his faith. The word that repeatedly arises in descriptions of Faraday is "humble." He refused to use the title "Doctor," rejected a knighthood, turned down the presidency of the Royal Society, never patented his inventions, and for most of his life rejected offers of a government pension until finally accepting a very modest one. He gave away at least half of his earnings, yet never let his name be used when making donations. He also loved children and began the annual Christmas Lectures for children at the Royal Institution in London – an event that continues to this day. His was a faith of one who not only hears, but *acts*.

Chances are, none of us will reach the heights of intellectual achievement, fame, and influence reached by Michael Faraday. But we are capable of sharing Faraday's faith, commitment, and humility. Yes, Faraday was a scientist par excellence, but he was first and foremost a Christian who dedicated himself to living out his faith in real, tangible ways: humility, kindness, generosity. His eyes were set on his Lord and the treasures that are above, and his life was evidence of that fact. May we learn from the example of our brother in Christ, Michael Faraday, and commit ourselves equally to our Lord. And who knows, as we learn from Faraday's example of humility and dedication, maybe some of us will even learn to appreciate  $\epsilon = -N(d\phi/dt)$ .
